Why is the Yangtze River economic belt important?

The Yangtze River Economic Belt is the backbone of China's economy, generating more than 40% of the country's total economic output, and is the economic region with the strongest comprehensive strength and the greatest strategic support in China.

Is the Yangtze River a high-level digital agglomeration zone?

The Yangtze River's downstream cities have become critical high-level digital agglomeration zones. (2) The difference in ULIU level between upstream and downstream of the Yangtze River Economic Belt is more prominent, and the dynamic transfer between tiers is relatively smooth.

How resilient is urban logistics in the Yangtze River Delta?
