

How many metric tons a year do Peruvian port terminals carry?

The Peruvian port terminals, for public and private use, mobilized 103.9 million metric tons in 2017, representing a growth of 10% in comparison with 2016 when 94.4 million metric tons were registered. Except for 2013 when their cargo volumes soared, they have been on a steady rise since 2010.

How many ports are there in Peru?
